The Gemischte Chor Zurich, founded in 1863, is one of the leading mixed choruses in Zurich. It regularly performs the great choral works in the Tonhalle to critical acclaim. www.gemischter-chor.ch

Anton Bruckner (1824 –1896) was an Austrian composer known for his symphonies, masses, and motets. The Mass in F minor marks a turning point in the life of Bruckner, then aged 44: crowning his long years of apprenticeship, it announces the series of masterpieces he went on to compose during his years in Vienna.

Bruckner's music is the culmination of the long tradition of Austro-German Romanticism.
